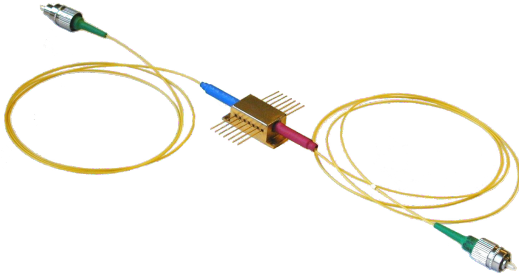


Semiconductor Optical Amplifier 790nm



SOA-790-14BF Semiconductor Optical Amplifier (SOA) is single-pass, traveling-wave amplifier that perform well with both monochromatic and multi-wavelength signals. The SOA consists of a highly efficient Multiple Quantum Well (MQW) layer structure.
